

Edmonton Folk Music Festival – EFMF 2026 50/50 Cash and Prizes RAFFLE

RAFFLE RULES

1. The Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society (EFMFS, EFMF, the festival) has established and will maintain rules to govern the conduct of the draw and awarding of the prize. Complete rules are available to ticket buyers, if requested.
2. Raffle tickets shall not be sold to a person less than 18 years of age and the name of a minor must not be written on the ticket. Ticket sellers will advise adult ticket buyers not to write the name of a person under 18 years of age on the ticket. Winners must be 18 years or older to claim a prize. If it is determined prior to the draw that a ticket has been issued to a minor, the ticket is deemed void and the purchaser will be refunded.
3. Ticket buyers must be located in Alberta at the time of purchase. Persons visiting from out of province may purchase a ticket if the entire transaction of payment and receipt of ticket occurs while the person is in Alberta.
4. If a winning ticket has more than one name affiliated with it, the prize will be awarded to only one (first name listed on the ticket) of the individuals identified on the ticket. The EFMFS and the AGLC are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
5. There are no ticket buying restrictions for members or volunteers of the Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society and their family members.
6. Owners and/or employees of Rafflebox and employees and immediate family of the employees of the Edmonton Folk Music Festival will not be eligible to purchase tickets.
7. All ticket sales are final. Once a ticket has been purchased, refunds or exchanges will not be granted. Lost tickets cannot be replaced.
8. A minimum of \$20,000 worth of tickets must be sold before a draw date extension is requested.
9. Draws will be open to the public. Early Bird draws and Main Draws will be conducted during the Edmonton Folk Music Festival at Gallagher Park, 9411 97 Ave NW, Edmonton, AB T6C 4N4.
10. One ticket number per prize will be drawn in the following order using a Random Number Generator on the following dates and times:
Early Bird Draw - August 8, 2026 (10:00 PM MDT)
 1. Music, and More Music! Prize
 2. Silver Tarp Prize**Main Draw - August 9, 2026 (10:30 PM MDT)**
 1. Ticketmaster Entertainment Prize

2. Flights to Anywhere! Prize
 3. Special Draw: Gold Tarp Prize
 4. Main Draw: 50/50 Cash Draw
11. Sales Dates/Deadlines/Draws:
- a. **Sales will begin on July 27, 2026.**
 - b. **Early Bird sales deadline is 10:00 PM MDT Saturday, August 8, 2026.** All tickets purchased before the Early Bird deadline will be eligible for both the Early Bird prizes and the Main Draw prizes. Purchases made after the Early Bird sales deadline will only be eligible for the Main Draw.
 - c. **Main Draw sales deadline is 10:30 PM MDT Sunday, August 9, 2026.**
 - d. Early Bird and Main Draws will commence immediately following the corresponding sales deadlines.
12. All winning tickets will be included in and be eligible to win subsequent non-identical prize draws.
13. All prizes are guaranteed for one month and must be claimed within one month from the date of draw. If after that time a prize(s) has still not been claimed, with the approval of AGLC, the prize(s) will be returned back to the Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society.
14. For some prizes, select dates and restrictions may apply:
- The Westin Edmonton hotel room has been reserved for arrival August 5, 2027 for four nights, changes to this reservation must be made 72 hours in advance, room types are subject to availability, blackout dates may apply, and the gift certificate expires on August 9, 2027.
 - The Ticketmaster Canada tickets are restricted to select dates; winner must contact Ticketmaster Canada via the Edmonton Folk Music Festival office by September 11, 2026.
 - The Winspear, The Arden Theatre tickets are restricted to specified show dates; winner must contact the Edmonton Folk Music Festival office by September 10, 2026 to arrange ticket delivery.
 - The Edmonton Folk Music Festival tickets and VIP backstage passes are restricted to the 2027 Edmonton Folk Music Festival.
 - Airfare from Edmonton International Airport for round-trip, non-stop travel to anywhere WestJet flies must be booked within 60 days of the prize draw (October 10, 2026). Travel voucher includes airfare only, is non-transferable, travel must be completed within one (1) year of draw date (by August 9, 2027), and is subject to availability at time of reservation. Voucher is for travel for two (2) people travelling on the same itinerary. Release form must be completed by flight winner. Winner must be 18 years of age or older to claim.
15. If the winner of a prize that has subscription or expiry dates, as noted in 14 above, claims their prize within one month of the draw date, but the concert/event/hotel room has been cancelled due to circumstances beyond the EFMFS' control, the Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society will award the winner comparable tickets or hotel room chosen by and at the Edmonton Folk Music Festival's discretion.
16. Non-cash prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash, except at the sole discretion of the Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society.

17. All non-cash prizes are new.

19. In the event of a power failure at sales or draw time, the sales or draws will be resumed and completed as soon as power is resumed.

RAFFLE RULES TICKET REQUIREMENTS AND SALES

1. 1,290,999 tickets will be available with this license.
2. The Edmonton Folk Music Festival will sell tickets at varied ticket levels including 1 for \$10.00, 10 for \$20.00, 50 for \$50.00, and 200 for \$100.00 price points.
3. For the Cash Draw, one winner will be awarded 50% of all raffle proceeds up to \$499,995.00. Each Non-Cash Prize Package will be awarded to one winner per package.
4. Raffle tickets will be sold online and in-venue. Ticket buyers must be in Alberta at the time of purchase.
5. Tickets purchased online shall be delivered via email to purchaser by the registered Electronic Raffle Supplier (ERS) Rafflebox. Tickets purchased in-venue will be printed and given to the purchaser.
6. No purchases are available through subscriptions.
7. Winning ticket numbers will be announced via the Edmonton Folk Music Festival's social media channels and website within 24 hours of each draw.
 - i. The EFMF will attempt to contact winners within 1 week after the conclusion of the draws.
 - ii. Winners will need to provide a photo of their winning ticket, with a piece of government issued ID.
 - iii. Winners have up to one month from the date of the draw to claim their prize.
8. The EFMF will arrange transfer of prizes to winners in the most convenient and safest way. Pick up of the non-cash prizes will be arranged with the winners; prizes requiring shipping will be shipped at the winner's expense. The cash prize will be paid to the winner via cheque.
9. By playing you consent to having your name and winning ticket number published.

LEGAL DETERMINATION OF OFFICIAL WINNER(S): It is the Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society's sole discretion to determine whether each Potential Winner is an official winner of a Prize (an "Official Winner"). The decision concerning the identity of all Official Winners shall be final and binding. To become an Official Winner: (1) a Potential Winner must be eligible to

participate in the Raffle under these Official Rules and must not be in violation of these Official Rules as determined by the Sponsor's sole judgment.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Entrants, by participating in the Raffle, agree that Edmonton Folk Music Festival Society and Rafflebox, each of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, partners, and advertising and promotion agencies, and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives, shareholders, members, consultants and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") will have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless by entrants against, any liability for injuries, losses, cost, expenses or damages of any kind, including damages for death, personal injury, property damage.
